COMMUNITY REMINDERS

SAFETY:

<u>Hillcreek Swimming Pool Rules</u>

The rules and regulations are established for the health, welfare, and safety of all members and their guests. The pool is primarily for member use. All Guests must be accompanied at all times by an owner within the community. No more than $\frac{5}{2}$ guests are allowed per visit per owner. Guests should not be provided keys. All guests are subject to all rules and regulations that apply to members. Conduct of guest is the direct responsibility of the member who sponsors them. Occupancy is limited to 49. Hours: 7:00 am - 10:00 pm.

Pool rules highlights are posted in the Hall of the clubhouse and on fences at the pool.

General: - All swimming is at your own risk <u>No lifeguards</u> are on duty.

-The Association accepts no responsibility for loss of money or the loss or

damage to personal articles.

-No one shall use the pool at any time other than scheduled hours Unauthorized

use of the pool after hours will constitute a trespass of private property and

violators are subject to prosecution by Richmond County Sheriff.

- No pets, bicycles, skateboards or any other motorized land conveyances are Allowed in the pool area.
- An adult should accompany children under 12 at all times.
- At <u>No time shall glass</u>, bottles, chinaware or items in breakable containers be allowed in the pool or pool deck area.
- Climbing on the fence is prohibited.
- There is <u>No Smoking</u>, chewing tobacco or vaping allowed within the pool enclosure. Smoking is allowed outside the pool fence: all cigarettes must be disposed of in appropriate containers. Please be respectful and ensure smoke does not affect other members.
- No Swimming permitted during thunderstorms.

Health & Safety:

- All commonly recognized rules of sanitation and safety shall be observed at all times.
- Members are requested to instruct their children and guest's children in personal hygiene and instruct them to use the restroom facilities in the clubhouse.
- Only persons in <u>swimming attire</u> are permitted in the pool. No cut-offs are allowed because loose threads may damage the filter system. Infants must wear swim diapers. Dirty diapers may not be disposed of I the restrooms or pool trash cans. All diapers should be tied in a plastic bag and taken home for disposal.
- Members are expected to refrain from using the pool when sick, with an open wound, or when wearing a bandage or Band-Aid of any type.
- Absolutely no diving in the pool or flips from the side. Running, pushing, dunking, sitting on shoulders and rough play are prohibited inside the pool at any time.
- Approved life jackets may be worn in the pool. No rafts or large flotation devices shall be allowed in the pool. Balls, toys, etc. will be allowed based on how crowded the pool is. No electrical devices on the pool deck.
- <u>Food and beverages</u> may be brought to the pool. County regulations prohibit food or beverages around the pool's edge. Members are responsible properly disposing of their own refuse in the pool trashcans. Spilled food and drinks are to be cleaned up
- <u>2</u>and the area rinsed with water. Alcoholic beverages are permitted by members and guests of legal age 21 years or older (**NO GLASS ALLOWED IN POOL ENCLO-SURE**). No one in an intoxicated state will be allowed in the pool area due to liability reasons.

<u>Conduct</u> at the pool must be such as to furnish the greatest pleasure for the greatest number. The cooperation of all members is expected. Appropriate behavior is expected by all members and their guests.

Foul or abusive language to members will not be tolerated. Major violations such as drug use, fighting or sexual misconduct will result in immediate dismissal from the pool area with notification of the Sheriff's office. The HOA has the authority to vacate all parsons from the pool deck area if, at their discretion, the pool enclosure is in a condition to endanger the health and safety of the members. The pool will remain vacated until the condition is corrected.

When leaving the pool area, **please be sure umbrellas are closed** and furniture has been returned to appropriate placement. Please pick up your trash etc. when leaving the pool.

For incidents at the pool, please notify a board member or Sheriff's office as appropriate.
